**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

***Effective immediately, all animals entered in and present at all AOBA Certified Shows will be required to be negative for BVDV using a PCR or VI test.***

All alpacas must have two copies of a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection **within 30 days** of the show with an entry permit. Call 501-907-2400 for entry permit. TB & Brucellosis tests are **NOT** required. Each alpaca entering the show venue **must also be micro-chipped**, according to the 2006 rule book, and **BVD test negative** on the health certificate. ## **THE FACILITY**

The facility, Hot Springs Convention Center, is superb! It is fully climate controlled. The stalls will be 10 x 10 panels on concrete flooring. One bag of cardboard bedding will be supplied with each animal stall and please provide a mat for each stall. Each stall is limited to 3 alpacas (crias do count).

## **REGISTRATION**

All alpacas must be registered and entered in the name of the current owner as listed on the ARI Registration Certificate. A "Permission to Show" form signed by the owner as listed on the ARI Certificate must be attached if an alpaca is being purchased and the transfer of the ARI certificate is not yet complete.

Alpacas must be checked in and color checked Friday, April 13, between 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Doors will be locked at 8:00 p.m.
